The Hospice is an independent charity which provides services free of charge.

Our services cost £6.6 million a year to run or £13 a minute.

We rely heavily on the support of the local community. More than three quarters of our income is generated by the public in ways such as fundraising, our lottery, Hospice shops, donations and leaving money in wills.

Playing our lottery is a simple way for you to support your local Hospice. Please help us to make each day count; just £1 a week can make a difference to lives of local people.

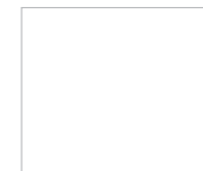

Play and win with St Elizabeth Hospice Lottery

We like to think of the lottery as a win-win situation – you have the chance of winning a prize each week and you are supporting your local Hospice at the same time. There are 59 prizes each week, including a £1,000 first prize, and the cheques are sent by post each Friday after the draw.

1st Prize: £1,000

2nd prize: **£150**

2 x £100 | 5 x £50 | 50 x £10

It's so easy to join!

Since the lottery was established in 2001, people like you have raised over £1.6 million in lottery proceeds to care and support thousands of local people. This ensures we are able to continue providing our services to patients and their families in the future.

It is just £1 each week to play the lottery and the top prize is £1,000. About two thirds of your £1 goes towards running the Hospice's services, the rest goes in prizes and we keep running costs to a minimum.

There are many ways you can play the lottery although playing by direct debit saves you time and saves the Hospice money. If you join by direct debit, we will write to you confirming your first payment date, the amount and frequency that payment will be collected, e.g. monthly.

It's easy to join, just fill in the form (or join online via our website), send it back to us and we'll do the rest.

You will be sent a welcome letter in the post which will contain your lucky numbers and confirms your entry in the St Elizabeth Hospice Lottery. Please allow up to two weeks to receive your welcome letter.

Complete this form indicating how many chances you would like each week and how you want to pay. One chance is £4.34 a month and two chances is £8.68 a month. Please consider joining with two chances – it gives you a better chance of winning and increases the amount raised for Hospice services. Please contact us if you want to play with three or more weekly chances.

If you are one of the 59 lucky winners in the weekly draw each Friday, you will be sent your prize cheque directly in the mail, so there is no need to claim a prize.

The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits.
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit St Elizabeth Hospice, Suffolk will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request St Elizabeth Hospice, Suffolk to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by St Elizabeth Hospice, Suffolk or your bank or building society you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society.
- If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when St Elizabeth Hospice, Suffolk asks you to.
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
