

TREK MONT BLANC

26th – 30th August 2010

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. For this Challenge we require a registration fee of £200 (non-refundable), which should be enclosed with your application form (made payable to Classic Tours).
2. There are two payment options for this challenge:
 - A. - You will pay the registration fee of £200 yourself and commit to raising a minimum sponsorship of £1400 in aid of St Elizabeth Hospice. This way St Elizabeth Hospice retains over £700 of the money you raise while the rest will go to pay the balance of your tour cost. We will invoice St Elizabeth Hospice, 8 weeks prior to departure, to cover the tour cost minus the registration fee. We will invoice you for the airport tax 8 weeks prior to departure. Until Classic Tours has received your airport tax your place on the challenge is not confirmed.

You will pay all your sponsorship money to St Elizabeth Hospice, not Classic Tours. St Elizabeth Hospice will need to receive 50% of your minimum sponsorship by 17th June 2010, 10 weeks before departure (this will cover your tour cost). You will need to pay St Elizabeth Hospice the remaining sponsorship by 25th October 2010, 8 weeks following the end of your trip.
 - B. - You will pay £658 yourself (full tour cost £858 less the registration fee). You will also be asked to raise as much sponsorship as you can for your chosen charity, but we ask for you to aim to raise £700. You will pay all your sponsorship money to St Elizabeth Hospice, not Classic Tours by 12th August 2010, 2 weeks prior to departure. 8 weeks prior to departure, Classic Tours will invoice you for the tour cost minus the registration fee plus airport taxes.
3. The tour cost is based on a minimum of 30 people taking part. If the number falls below this level the tour cost may increase.
4. You MUST notify St Elizabeth Hospice that you will be participating in this challenge and raising funds in their name. They may require you to sign their terms and conditions.
5. Upon receipt of your registration form we will seek written confirmation from St Elizabeth Hospice that you have contacted them, that they have authorised you to raise funds in their name, and that they will be invoiced for the balance of your tour costs. Once we have received this from St Elizabeth Hospice we will confirm your successful registration.
6. All funds raised in connection to this challenge should be paid directly to St Elizabeth Hospice.

7. When fundraising you MUST make clear to donors what proportion of funds raised are going to the charity and how much towards costs.
8. Should you, for whatever reason, cancel your place on the challenge, the cancellation terms are set out in the Classic Tours booking conditions.
9. If you withdraw in circumstances where recovery of cancellation charges is indemnified under your travel insurance, you hereby agree that you will co-operate in the recovery of these charges from the insurers and any sums recovered under the policy will be paid to the charity.
10. Should you have to withdraw, all sponsor forms and monies should be forwarded to St Elizabeth Hospice or returned to the sponsor.
11. If you are unable to meet the sponsorship money requirements, you will forfeit your place. However, you may choose to make up the balance yourself.
12. Except as stated in the booking conditions, the registration fee is non-refundable.
13. You must be at least 18 years old before the departure date of the event.
14. You must not suffer from alcohol or drug dependency or have any criminal convictions.
15. Classic Tours specialises in challenges of this nature and is fully bonded by the Civil Aviation Authority, ATOL 3379 and Travel Organisers Failure Travel (TOFC). Classic Tours is unable to accept liability for any loss or damage; however arising, or for the cancellation of the event for any reasons outside their control.
16. Itineraries, schedules and accommodation may change and other alterations may occur which are beyond the control of Classic Tours.
17. Your passport must have at least six months to run from the date you return to the UK.
18. You must wear a cycle helmet at ALL times when cycling.
19. You participate at your own risk. If you are refused passage and/or entry/exit to or from the country that you are visiting, any additional costs incurred are your responsibility.
20. You must have adequate travel insurance that will cover you for the specific activities you will be undertaking, including medical expenses and emergency repatriation. You will be asked to provide proof of travel insurance 8 weeks prior to the event, or you may forfeit your place on the challenge.
21. Classic Tours may, at their sole discretion, withdraw places on the Trek Mont Blanc Challenge if it is believed to be in their best interest to do so.
