## St Elizabeth Hospice Providing care since 1989

St Elizabeth Hospice is an independent Suffolk charity that delivers care to thousands of patients and their families throughout East & Mid-Suffolk, Great Yarmouth and Waveney. We support those living with a progressive or life-limiting illness.

The majority of care is given in people's homes or community settings and is entirely free.

St Elizabeth Hospice services cost around £12 million each year, with the charity raising 70% of funds via revenue streams and the generosity of the community through support of its retail shops and fundraising activities.

We've also been providing services in Great Yarmouth and Waveney since 2019, in partnership with East Coast Community Healthcare. In 2023, our services in Great Yarmouth and Waveney merged with the organisation East Coast Hospice. We have specialist palliative care beds at Beccles Hospital as well as support in the community in people's homes.



## Hares for the hospice!

One family who understands the importance of our services are the Dormans - and they've had the special honour of naming the first hare sculpture for this year's trail.

Amelie and Noah Dorman shared a list of name ideas and after a vote among hospice staff and volunteers, the winning name was 'Skye'. This is now proudly carried by a hare designed by artist Lois Cordelia, a long-time supporter of our art trails.

Amelie and Noah's daddy, James Dorman, received care from the hospice before his death from cancer in 2022, aged just 37.

Claire Dorman, Amelie and Noah's mum, said: "We were so touched to be asked to name the first hare for the 2025 trail.

"I'm so proud of Amelie and Noah, they understand how well the hospice took care of their Daddy and how well they continue to look out for us as a family. They are passionate in their support of the hospice in the same way that I am.

"We feel so lucky to have been a part of Hop to it! Suffolk 2025 and we have such special memories of completing the previous trails in Ipswich with their Daddy & our closest friends.

"Amelie and Noah's favourite was Elmer's Big Parade in 2019, where we finished at the town hall and splashed in the fountains!"

## Our Sculptures

Hop to it! Suffolk 2025 features three different types of hare sculpture. This is the first time there have been more than two types of sculpture in a St Elizabeth Hospice art trail. Below you can read more about each sculpture and how they will feature in Hop to it! Suffolk 2025.

- 1 Large 'Hop to it! Hare (ears up)**  
This is the main sculpture in Ipswich. All of these sculptures have been painted by commissioned artists and will be located in Ipswich.
- 2 Large 'Stargazer' Hare (ears down)**  
The main sculpture in all of our satellite locations. All of these sculptures have also been painted by commissioned artists.
- 3 Small 'Stargazer' Leveret**  
Most of the smaller sculptures will feature art by schools and groups who are participants in the Hopscotch Learning & Community Programme. A small selection of leverets have also been designed and painted by commissioned artists as part of the Hop to it! trail. They will be the only leverets available to buy at auction.

Our hop-tastic hares will take centre stage at an auction to raise money for St Elizabeth Hospice.

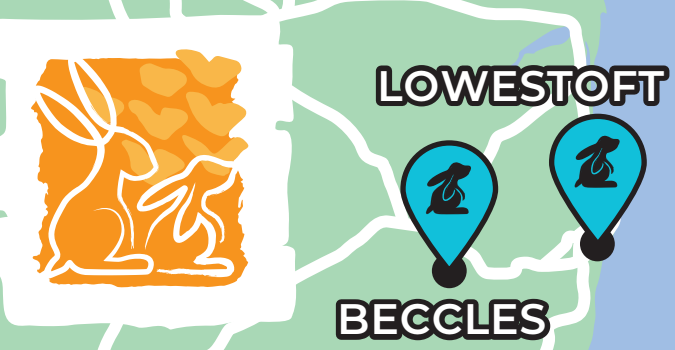

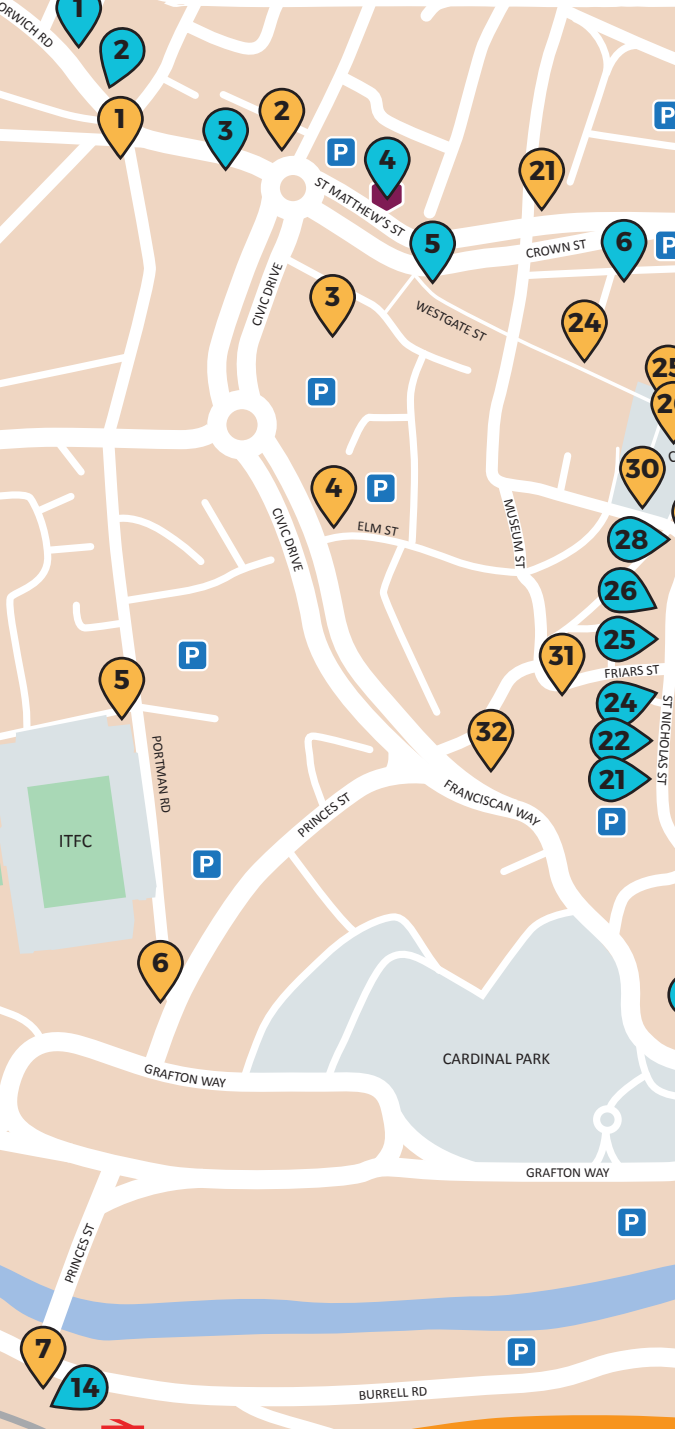
