St Elizabeth Hospice is an independent Suffolk charity that delivers care to thousands of patients and their families throughout East & Mid-Suffolk, Great Yarmouth and Waveney. We support those living with a progressive or life-limiting illness.

The majority of care is given in people's homes or community settings and is entirely free.

St Elizabeth Hospice services cost around £12 million each year, with the charity raising 70% of funds via revenue streams and the generosity of the community through support of its retail shops and fundraising activities.

We've also been providing services in Great Yarmouth and Waveney since 2019, in partnership with East Coast Community Healthcare. In 2023, our services in Great Yarmouth and Waveney

merged with the organisation East Coast Hospice. We have specialist palliative care beds at Beccles Hospital as well as support in the community in people's homes.

One family who understands the importance of our services are the Dormans - and they've had the special honour of naming the first hare sculpture for this year's trail.

Amelie and Noah Dorman shared a list of name ideas and after a vote among hospice staff and volunteers, the winning name was 'Skye'. This is now proudly carried by a hare designed by artist Loïs Cordelia, a long-time supporter of our art trails.

Hop to it! Suffolk 2025 features three different types of hare sculpture. This is the first time there have been more than two types of sculpture in a St Elizabeth Hospice art trail. Below you can read more about each sculpture and how they will feature in Hop to it! Suffolk 2025.

Large 'Hop to it!' Hare (ears up) This is the main sculpture in Ipswich. All of these sculptures have been painted by commissioned artists and will be located in Ipswich.

2 Large 'Stargazer' Hare (ears down) The main sculpture in all of our satellite locations. All of these sculptures have also been painted by commissioned artists.

Small 'Stargazer' Leveret Most of the smaller sculptures will feature art by schools and groups who are participants in the Hopscotch Learning & Community Programme.
