



## Terms and Conditions

### – Regular Giving offer with Free Prize Draw Entries

These terms and conditions apply to the promotional offer under which eligible supporters who sign up to become a regular giver will receive free entries into a prize draw offer - A Fred Olsen Cruise for two departing from Southampton, staying on-board Borealis on a 3-night Belgium mini cruise on 18 January 2027. D Grade ocean view cabin. By taking part in the offer, entrants are deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions.

### How to qualify for free entries:

1. To qualify for the Offer, a supporter must successfully set up a new regular gift to St Elizabeth Hospice (SEH) during the promotional period using one of the methods specified by the SEH
2. A “regular gift” means a recurring donation by Direct Debit, recurring card payment, or other recurring payment method expressly accepted by SEH
3. The minimum regular gift amount required to qualify is £5 per month.
4. The promotional period opens on Monday 15 June 2026 and closes on Monday 14 September 2026. The Main Draw will be held on Wednesday 16 September 2026. Entries received outside this period will not be eligible unless SEH states otherwise in writing.
5. Eligible supporters will receive:
  - three free prize draw entries/tickets when signing up to regular giving at £5 per month and
  - ten free prize draw entries when signing up to regular giving at £10 per month.
6. Unless expressly stated otherwise, only one Offer entry allocation is permitted per person.

### Important offer conditions: regular giving, cancellations and refunds:

1. This Offer is a promotional incentive connected with becoming a regular giver.
2. By setting up a regular gift, the supporter authorises the relevant recurring payment instruction in accordance with the payment method selected.
3. The regular gift will continue until amended or cancelled by the supporter or SEH in accordance with the applicable Direct Debit or payment terms.
4. Cancellation of a regular gift after free entries have been allocated does not create any right to any refund, replacement entry or compensation, save where required by law.
5. Nothing in these terms affects any refund rights that may arise under the Direct Debit Guarantee or other mandatory legal protections.
